Any meter remaining inactive for less than 5 years will require payment of a reconnect fee prior to reconnection of service. Any meter remaining inactive for 5 – 9 years will require payment of a reconnect fee plus time and materials prior to reconnection of service. Water meters remaining inactive for 10 years or more shall be removed after an attempt to notify the property owner. Water meters removed for inactivity will incur the cost of a new meter installation fee if request is made for reinstallation. Installation fee will be per current rates for a New Tap.
